



TATUNG announced its 2007 consolidated financial results on April 30th, 2008.

2007 consolidated revenue reached NT\$228,991 million or 20.44% higher than that of 2006. However, gross profit advanced 303.40% to NT\$33,504 million from NT\$8,306 million a year earlier, boosted by Chunghwa Picture Tubes turnaround, profit growth in Shan Chih Semiconductor Corp. (“SCSC”), Green Energy Technology (“GET”), and Shan Chih Asset Development (“SCAD”). Henceforth, gross margin rose to 14.63% from 4.37% in previous year. Operating income turned to positive NT\$13,097 million from operating loss of NT\$10,620 million, up 223.33% from 2006. Non-operating income climbed by 60.8% to NT\$7,565 million. Investment income accounted NT\$4,033 million, primarily generated from divestment in GET at NT\$2,024 million. Non-operating expense decreased by NT\$879 million to NT\$9,330 million from the previous year due to the reduction in non-recurring asset impairment and inventory or obsolescence loss.

2007 consolidated profits gained NT\$10,479 million, an increase by 160.20% from the previous year. Earnings per share on the consolidated basis was NT\$2.39, up from negative NT\$4.20 in 2006. TATUNG’s net income generated NT\$3,577 million in 2007 and earnings per share rose to NT\$0.81, increased by 143.72% and 141.12% respectively.
